"In connection with the imminent signing on March 2018 of the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (the "Agreement"), I have the honour to confirm the following understanding reached between the Government of Malaysia and Unique Transition of Malaysia and Transition of Malaysi

- 1. The Government of New Zealand will refrain from seeking recourse to Chapter 28 (Dispute Settlement) of the Agreement with respect to the commitment of Malaysia regarding PETRONAS as contained in subparagraphs (a) through (hair that Second Non-Conforming Activities of Annex IV = MALAYSIA = 3 for a period of five years after the entry into force of the Agreement for Malaysia.
